Dates and Location

All groups, unless otherwise noted, will meet for 4 weeks beginning the week of July 7th. The ensembles will present an informal performance on Thursday, July 31st. All classes are held in the MHS Music Area, and are taught by experienced, professional music educators.

Registration

Course Offerings

Elementary Band Mrs. Egan
Tuesday & Thursday 4:00– 5:00 PM

Open to students entering grades 5 or 6 who have played a Band instrument for at least one year. Focus will be on improving technique and ensemble skill in a structured, but informal setting.

Elementary String Ensemble Ms. Ridarelli
July 7-11 2:30-3:30 PM

Open to students entering grades 4,5,6 who have played a string instrument for at least one year. Focus will be on posture and position and developing ensemble skills.

Jr. Jazz Ensemble..... TBA
Tuesday & Thursdays 5:00-7:00 PM

Open to students entering grades 6-8. Student must have studied piano, guitar, bass or a band instrument for at least two years. Focus will be on introducing and improving jazz concepts for performance.

Jazz Improvisation..... Mr. Thomas
Tuesday & Thursdays 4:00– 6:00 PM

Open to intermediate/advanced jazz musicians (students entering grades 9-12) interested in improving their jazz improvisation and theory skills.

Summer Band Mr. Thomas
Tuesdays 6:30– 8:30 PM

Open to Band students entering grades 8-12. Focus will be on continued improvement of ensemble skills and technique in a structured, but informal setting.

Summer String EnsembleMs. Ridarelli
Wednesdays..... 4:00-6:00 PM

Open to string students entering grades 7-12. Focus will be on improvement of ensemble skills and musicianship while previewing music to be studied and performed in the upcoming school year.

Chamber Ensembles Various Teachers
Time and day to be determined by teacher/student.

Students interested in playing in a quartet, quintet, or other small ensemble will be coached by professional musicians. Groups will be developed based upon instrumentation and playing level.

Private Lessons

Private lessons are offered on all Band and String instruments as well as voice. We urge students who are currently studying privately to continue to do so, and we encourage other students to consider this option. Private lessons are scheduled by the teacher and student directly.

The fee is \$20.00 per 30 minute lesson and students must enroll for at least 5 lessons. The fee (\$100) is payable directly to the teacher at the first lesson.
